

Some people may not know that we have a thriving satellite BBBS office in Madras! Program Coordinator, Alex Penaloza has worked hard to build and foster a Site-Based program this year, resulting in twenty-six high school students mentoring Littles from two local elementary schools.

He recently organized a QPR training with these high school students to teach them practical and proven suicide prevention techniques. Furthermore, Alex invited these Site-Based matches to a "Bingo Lunch", where they played Bingo, had lunch and discussed the importance of recognizing bullying behaviors and ways to prevent bullying. During another Site-Based event, local Jefferson County Firefighter Onasis Adame spoke to the Bigs and Littles about firefighting and why he does this very important work. Soon the Site-Based matches will have their end of the year party, where they will celebrate the friendships formed during the past school year with fun games and tasty snacks!
